

Guidelines for Authors

Accompanying the 18th European Symposium on Comminution & Classification, 24th – 26th June 2024, Miskolc - Hungary, the Book of Extended Abstracts will be published on-line in the web page of the symposium. In order to generate an informative and uniform publication we are asking all authors to satisfy the following guidelines.

The deadline for the submission of the extended abstract is **22nd February 2024!**

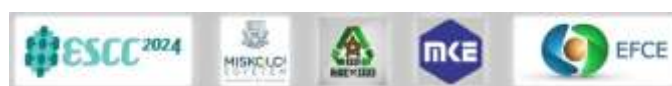
General remarks

The language of the publication as well as of the symposium is English. The usage of American or British English is accepted but not a mixture of these. SI units should be used wherever possible. The proceeding will be published on-line, therefore any colours can be used and the extended abstracts will not be peer-reviewed. The extended abstract must not exceed 4 pages! The format of the paper must not vary from the attached template! Extended abstracts have to be handed in as “doc/docx” document.

Copyright and Author Rights

The copyright of the submitted extended abstracts for the ESCC2024 is transferred to the “Hungarian Chemical Society”. The authors have the right to reuse pictures, graphs and paragraphs for publication in Journals as long as the manuscript of the paper is not identical, i.e. also includes new and not published contents. The authors of the best papers will get the possibility to publish the paper after a peer-review process in a special issue of Chemical Engineering & Technology (CET). Other post-symposium publication options might be announced later.

Extended Abstracts have to be submitted by the ESCC2024 homepage (www.escc2024.mke.org.hu). Please follow the instructions to upload your Extended Abstract.
